\$250 per team  
The fee includes all shuttles, awards and 8 team T-shirts  
Extra shirts available for \$20 per shirt

### REGULATIONS

A team consists of 4 men and 4 women – teams may have a maximum of 6 men and 6 women registered but only 4 men and 4 women play each round.

Players must be representatives of the same university, college, badminton club or Ontario Winter Games 2018 team.

All players must be at least 16 years of age as of the date of the tournament in order to be eligible.

All registered teams get the same number of ties in the competition – no elimination.

**Each “tie” (or round) consists of 5 matches – 1 men’s singles, 1 women’s singles, 1 men’s doubles, 1 women’s doubles and 1 mixed doubles.**

Each player on a team may play in only one event per tie.

All play is with Victor feather shuttlecocks and all shuttlecocks are supplied for all matches.

Each match is best of 3 games rally point to 21 points (maximum of 30 points).

## AWARDS

All participants will receive a Ridgeback T-shirt at registration.

Medals for A team champions and finalists, B team champions and finalists and C team champions and finalists.

Most Outstanding male and female performers for each team will be presented Victor prizes at end of play as voted on by the players on each team.

## OTHER INFORMATION

During the day, our team members will be selling 50-50 tickets.

There will be 2 special awards during the day – these will be presented to an individual and an organization that have been supportive of our UOIT Ridgeback programme as we start a tradition of appreciation to our badminton community.
